"Electronic Tracking in Neuropsychiatric Symptom Management"

Speaker: Ron Calvanio, Ph.D.

BIO: Ron Calvanio, Ph.D. was Director of Neuropsychology at Spaulding Rehab for almost 20 years. He now splits his time between private practice at symtrend.com, grant funded research and consultation at the MGH neurology department. Dr. Calvanio's methodology is derived from his experience in rehabilitation settings and is an excellent complement to traditional assessment techniques for multisymptom presentations.

Learning Goals:

- 1) To learn how handheld computers can be used to manage a wide variety of neuro-psychiatric symptoms: pain, fatigue, emotional outbursts, impaired time perception, lapses of attention, memory failures, as well as complex multi-symptom presentations.
- 2) To gain and develop a different conception of Neuropsychological assessment: one that examines the symptom time course over days and weeks rather than over portions of one or two intensive encounters.
- 3) To learn how handheld computers and a different conception of Neuropsychological assessment turn the Neuropsychologist into an important treatment contributor through the detection--and reduction-- of contributing factors to symptom expression that do not show up on brain imaging, and never will.
